



ISSBA Awards – call for nominations

The International Society for the Study of Behavioral Addictions (ISSBA) established three awards to acknowledge **scientific excellence and significant contribution to the development of the field of behavioral addictions.**

The **Lifetime Achievement Award** is intended to be awarded to senior researchers to acknowledge their lifelong contribution to the scientific research of non-substance-related addictive disorders.

The **Early Career Researcher Award** will be awarded to junior colleagues within 5 years of receiving their terminal degree for their significant contributions to and impact on the academic study of behavioral addictions.

The **Great Achievement Award** will be awarded, regardless of the career phase, to colleagues who have performed transformative and innovative contributions that significantly impacted the study of behavioral addictions.
